The word **Guantanamo** was popularized worldwide since 2002. That year the U.S. Government opened a detention camp at a military base that bears that name to detain more than 1,000 suspected terrorists there. Few knew that the territory is a piece of land which belongs to Cuba but that is illegally occupied since 1903.

Cuban officials have made it clear that there are only two issues standing in the way of a fundamental improvement in U.S.-Cuban relations; ***"In order to achieve the normalization of relations between the two countries, the blockade has to be lifted and the territory occupied by the Naval base in Guantanamo has to be returned."***
